100 Strong Bandon to meet Nov. 15

BANDON - 100 Strong Bandon has only had two meetings, but is already off to a big start of making a difference in Bandon. The group is a giving circle, coordinated by the Bandon Chamber of Commerce, that supports local charities. Quarterly, the members meet, select a 501(c)(3) charity that benefits Bandon area residents and make a tax-deductible donation of \$50 or more directly to that charity, all within a one-hour meeting.

In addition, the charity selected by the group in the prior quarter presents a report on how they used the funds and thanks the donors. At the initial meeting for 100 Strong Bandon in May 2017, participants made a \$2,550 donation to Bandon Feeds the Hungry, supporting five area food assistance charities that have banded together to meet the needs of the hungry in the Bandon area.

The group next met in August and con-

tributed \$3,450 to the Bandon Community Preschool, a nonprofit charity dedicated to enriching the lives of preschool children and ensuring they are prepared to enter kindergarten.

There is no membership fee to join 100 Strong Bandon, and the Chamber does not retain any percentage of the funds donated to local charities. The goal is to reach 100+ members by the end of the year. Current membership is approximately 60. MaryAnn Soukup, founder, encourages all members to attend the November meeting and bring a friend.

The next meeting is Wednesday, Nov. 15, in the first floor room at Lord Bennett's, 1695 Beach Loop Drive SW. Doors will open at 5 p.m. and the meeting will run from 5:30-6:30 p.m.
