# Wyden hosts three town halls this week

PORTLAND - Senator Ron Wyden (D-Ore.) will hold town halls this week in Coos, Douglas and Curry counties.

These upcoming town halls will increase to 896 the number of town halls Wyden has held since pledging when first elected to hold annual town halls in each of Oregon's 36 counties.

"Open-to-all town halls play a big part in what I call the 'Oregon Way,' where any person can ask any question in a public meeting," Wyden said. "Throwing open the doors of government for town halls to have these conversations is a must in our democracy, and I look forward very much

to hearing from Southern Oregon next week."

The town hall schedule is as follows:

**Friday, May 4**

**Coos County:** 1 pm, North Bend High School gymnasium, 2323 Pacific Avenue, North Bend.
