# Bear spotted on Riverside Drive

**BANDON** - The Bandon Police Department is letting citizens know a young bear was sighted sitting alongside Riverside Drive on Saturday night, May 26. The bear quickly ran into the brush when a car approached the area.

Police do not believe the public is in danger. Anyone with questions or concerns can call the Bandon Police Department at 541-347-2241.

Oregon is home to about 25,000 to 30,000 black bears, North America's most common bear species. Generally black in color, they can also be brown, cinnamon or blond. Fast and agile, they are good swimmers and climbers who prefer forests, trails and

streams. At home throughout Oregon, black bears are omnivorous and have a diverse diet including berries, fruit, grasses and plants. Although they will consume small mammals, insects and amphibians, these bears are not usually active predators.

Bears should never be allowed access to human food or garbage; it habituates them to people and increases the chance of conflict. Once habituated to finding food near homes or campgrounds, bears can become a threat to human safety and must often be destroyed.

# Programs offered at Bullards Beach

**BANDON** - Bullards Beach State Park continues its summer programs for 2018. The programs run from 7-8 p.m. June 1 through Sept. 1, Tuesdays through Saturdays, with the exception of the Oregon Old Time Fiddlers, who will play from 2-3:30 p.m. on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month. The programs are held in either the amphitheater or the meeting yurt and are free and open to the public.

Carpooling or parking at the east side picnic area and walking into the campground is encouraged to avoid parking issues and traffic congestion. Allow enough time if walking in.

Bullards also has a top-notch Junior Ranger program that runs from 10-11 a.m. Tuesdays through Saturdays throughout the summer. On Saturdays, the Junior Rangers take part in a bicycle parade. They have a chance to decorate their bikes and learn bike safety

before the parade, then they ride throughout the park. All children are welcome.

This week's programs:

**Friday, June 1, 7 p.m., amphitheater:** "Bandon Beach Treasures" with Haven Andrist. Uncover the rocks, fossils and petrified wood found on our beaches and learn how to identify them.

# ‘Outside the Box’ to be presented June 1-3

BANDON - Six lives interconnect in surprising ways in “Outside the Box,” The Gaels Readers Theater’s new production written by local playwright Mike Dempsey.

“Outside the Box” will be performed one weekend only in the Bandon Public Library Sprague Room, 1204 11th St. SW. Performances are at 7 p.m. Friday, June 1, and Saturday, June 2, and at 2 p.m. Sunday, June 3. Admission is \$5 at the door. This production includes mature themes and language.

“These are people in very real circumstances,” said Dempsey. “Each lives in the aftermath of personal rejection and loss, surviving on humor and hope as they rediscover themselves.”

“Outside the Box” focuses on Lulu, a homeless woman being interviewed while living on the back streets of Las Vegas. She speaks about people forever “stuck” in

her memories - a beauty pageant queen, a teen runaway, a drag performer and others.

The cast includes Corrie Gant as Lulu, Cathy Underdown, Heather Bouher, Annie McGregor, Amy Moss Strong and Donald Zealand.

The Gaels bring original and lesser-known plays to life through readers theater. Reduced production costs allow admission prices to stay at \$5.
