'Tales from the Cemetery' program set for April 21

BANDON - "Tales from the Cemetery: Who's Buried at Bullards Beach," is the title of a program at the Bandon Historical Museum Saturday, April 21. Museum volunteer Jim Proehl is the speaker.

The Human Bean in Bandon is sponsoring the event. Admission to the program and to the museum for the day will be free, courtesy of the Human Bean.

The program will be delivered at 11 a.m. and repeated at 2 p.m. Recent museum programs have drawn capacity crowds.

The focus of the program will be on the small cemetery inside Bullards Beach State Park, where some of the area's earliest European American settlers are buried. Proehl draws extensively from the book, "Two Johns Come to America," a family history by Alice Hamblock Evans, to tell the story of how "Black John" Hamblock emigrated to America and ended up on the north bank of the Coquille River, and then how the Hamblock place became Bullards Ferry, before it evolved into Bullards Beach State Park.

"My hope is that after the program, people will visit the Bullards Cemetery and feel like they know everyone buried there. They each have an interesting story," said Proehl.

The program will be accompanied by pictures. There are a number of artifacts related to the Hamblock and Bullard families on display in the museum.

"We hope that doing the program twice will relieve some crowding," said Gayle Nix, museum director. "We are gratified that people come out to our programs but get a little embarrassed when the seating gets tight. You still may want to come early to get a good seat."

"We appreciate the sponsorship by the Human Bean, which allows the community to both attend the program and visit the museum for the day at no charge," said Nix.

The Bandon Historical Museum is located at the corner of U.S. Highway 101 and Fillmore Avenue. The museum is open Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and can be reached at 541-347-2164.
