Abigail Donowho	11/03/2014:	C	<p>Councilor Martin noted that Mayor Weber has been in office for four years and although she initially stated that the flooding on Birch would be taken care of, it is not yet completely addressed. He also noted that the State Highway needs to put a merge sign on Pacific and Main to show that the lanes coming from the East have to merge and don't have the right-of-way. The City Manager can bring this concern to ODOT.</p>

Councilor Sandusky said it's been four years since Mayor Weber has been in office and she is doing a great job.

Councilor Henson noted Cheryl Klingelhofer's letter that was distributed this evening. He asked that it be discussed at the next Council meeting. **Mayor Weber** noted that the letter relates to the **odor** of "Dairy Air" in Tillamook. Another letter has also been received on the matter from Val Crispin.

Citizen odor Concerns—Mayor Weber noted the information concerning the Dairy Air of Tillamook brought by Val Crispin and Sherryl Klingelhofer. Exhibits of current photos showing the covered manure tank were distributed. There are not currently any farms within the City Limits that are producing manure. **Councilor Martin** noted there are farmers who drive manure through town.

Abigail Donowho	11/17/2014:	C	<p>Councilor Henson spoke with the Hogan's and explained to the Council that the tank is covered and the smell has substantially decreased. The Hogan's are trying to be good neighbors and help alleviate some of the odor. The Council discussed the purpose and scope of such a large tank, that many holding tanks are in place to keep contaminants from running off into the slough or other bodies of water. Current regulations regarding manure storage and holding tanks reside with the Department of Agriculture.</p>

The Council agreed that the smell is unpleasant, but there is nothing that we, as a City, can do with it. The **odor** in question is not produced within the jurisdiction of the City limits.
