Building Up To **LOG CABINS**

Get in the Groove
Log-cabin builders cut notches near the ends of each log. The notches create an interlocking system that makes the log cabin a strong, stable structure. People from different countries often used different types of notches to construct their log cabins.

This Old House
In 1638, one of the first log cabins in North America was built by Swedish and Finnish immigrants along the Delaware River. The Nothnagle Log House, built about 1640, is one of the oldest surviving log houses in North America.
