Sarah Josepha Hale is often called "the mother of Thanksgiving," for her three-decades-long campaign to United States governors, senators and presidents to establish Thanksgiving as a national holiday. She is also known for her role in promoting the turkey in a traditional Thanksgiving meal.

Presidents of the United States have given presidential pardons to a turkey every Thanksgiving since George H.W. Bush made it a formal tradition in 1989.

Many "days of thanksgiving" were held in Colonial America before the Pilgrims' famous 1621 meal, including a Spanish celebration in Florida in 1565, the Jamestown celebration of 1610 and a Virginia celebration in 1619.
