n the late 1940s, inventor George Lerner came up with an idea for a children's toy that involved inserting detachable eyes, ears, noses and other accessories into ordinary vegetables like carrots and potatoes to create funny characters. He initially called his invention "Funny Face Man." After a name change and some groundbreaking marketing, Lerner's invention evolved into the popular toy we know today as Mr. Potato Head. 





