

## 2026 Bid Notice

Deerfield Township Supervisors of Tioga County, PA, 5322 Route 49, Knoxville, PA 16928, open the bidding process for the following:

- Various materials form 100% crushed rock 2RC (no larger than 1-1/2"), 2A and R4 riprap to be delivered and tailgate spread on various township roads or delivered to the township stockpile
- 2RC, from 100% crushed rock, must be Penn Dot approved, 2200 tons more or less, price per delivery to the township stockpile
- 2A, from 100% crushed rock, must be Penn Dot approved, 2200 tons more or less, price per delivery to the township stockpile
- 2A, from 100% crushed rock, must be Penn Dot approved, 2200 tons more or less, price per tailgate spread
- 2A, from 100% crushed rock, must be Penn Dot approved, 2200 tons more or less, priced per dump into the paver
- Sluice pipes of various sizes (15" through 48")
- Calcium chloride, 75 tons, more or less, Penn Dot approved, delivered to the township building
- Crack sealing material, Penn Dot approved, in 30 lb. blocks, 3 tons more or less, delivered to the township building.

1B, 2B, and anti-skid bids will be accepted from both quarries and gravel pits

- 1B, washed and Penn Dot approved, 220 tons, more or less, price per delivery to township stockpile
- 2 B, washed and Penn Dot approved, 220 tons, more or less, price per delivery to the township stockpile
- 2B, washed and Penn Dot approved, 220 tons, more or less, price per delivery to various township roads
- Anti-skid, Penn Dot approved, 500 tons more or less, delivered to the township building
- Cold patch, Penn Dot approved, 220 tons, more or less, delivered to the township building

All work and material must meet Pennsylvania Department of Transportation specifications for 408 dated 1994 and its supplements. Bid sheets may be picked up at the township office, Room 4, in the Knoxville Community Center, Main Street Knoxville, by calling 814-326-4930 for an appointment.

The bid must be in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Bid", and please include a return address. The successful bidder shall furnish a bond guaranteeing performance of the contract in the amount of 10% of the bid within 20 days after the contract is awarded as per Section 3102 (G) of the Second Class Township Code.

Bids will be accepted until 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, March 3, 2026. The office will be open from 9:00 A.M. until 11:00 A.M. expressly for this purpose on that day.

Bids will be opened at 7:15 P.M. during the regular Township Meeting in the Edwin A. Glover Conference Room in the Knoxville Community Center, Tuesday March 3, 2026.

Deerfield Township reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids or any parts of bids.

Contractors must have the ability to deliver at least 800 tons of material per day.
