Canisteo Wind Project

Beginning on or about September 23, 2026, Canisteo Wind Energy LLC (CWE) will install up to 16 stabilized construction entrances associated with the construction of an up to 290-megawatt (MW) wind-powered electric generation facility located in the Towns of Canisteo, Greenwood, Jasper, Troupsburg, and West Union, Steuben County, New York (Facility) (and up to 24 total stabilized construction entrances across both the Facility and related Transmission Facility).

This notice is being provided in accordance with Certificate Conditions 20 and 21 of the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) issued by the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (Siting Board) on March 13, 2020, authorizing the Facility. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

When completed, the Project will consist of up to 66 wind turbines with a maximum generating capability of 290 MW. The Project will also consist of associated improvements, including buried electrical cables, pad-mount transformers, access roads, an electrical substation, aircraft detection lighting systems, and an operations and maintenance (O&M) building. All Facility components will be located within an area encompassing approximately 12,422 acres (the Facility Site).

THE CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

The stabilized construction entrance (SCE) phase of construction is scheduled to begin on or about September 23, 2026, and last through December 31, 2026. Construction activity will be limited to the hours between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., or daylight hours outside this window, Monday through Saturday. The construction transportation routes are shown on the attached maps.

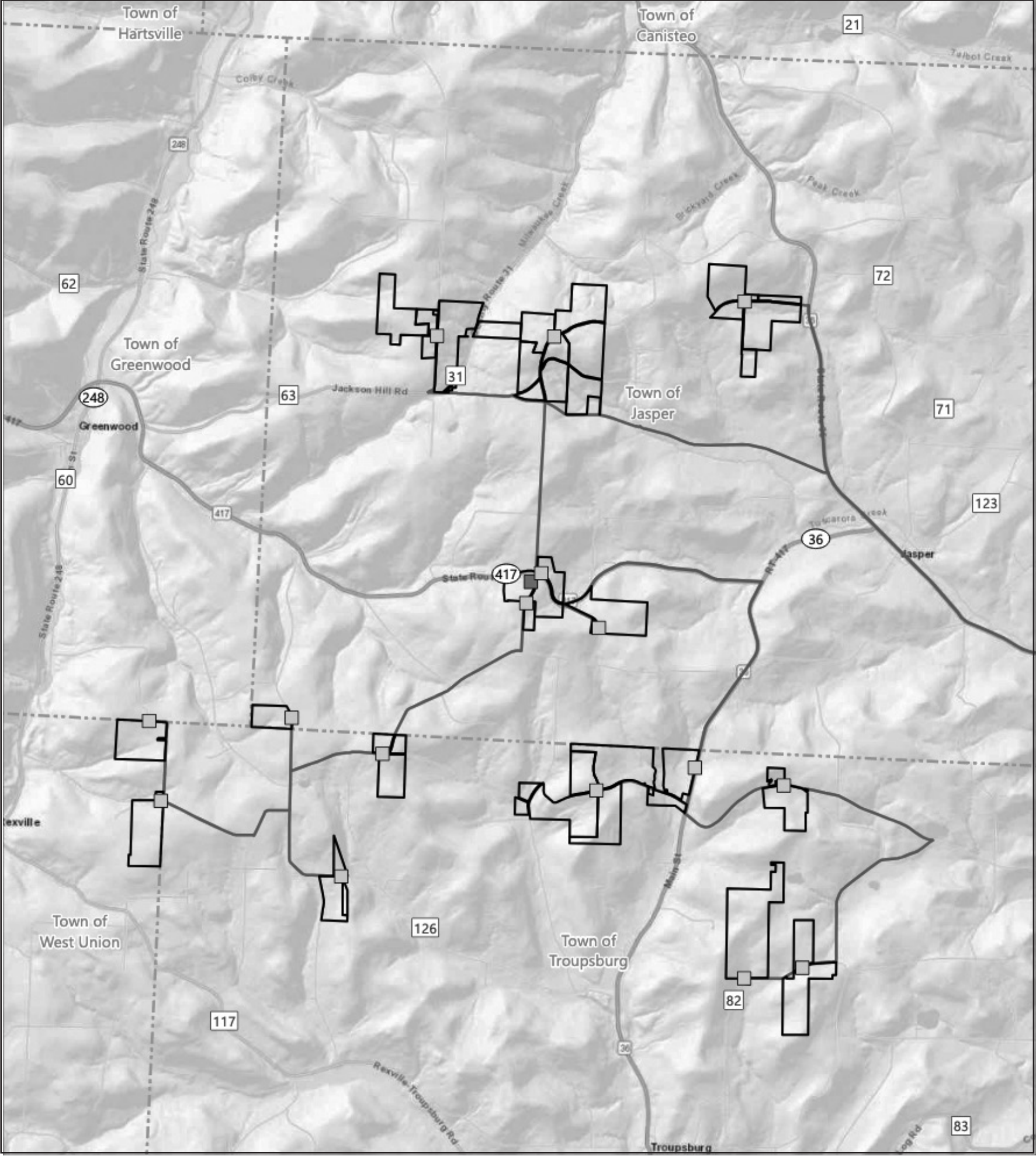
