

**NOTICE OF SECOND HEARING ON PROPOSED POTTER COUNTY'S APPLICATION FOR
DISASTER RECOVERY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS**

Notice is hereby given that Potter County will conduct a public hearing at 10:30 AM on Thursday, October 1, 2026, at the Commissioners Auditorium, Gunzburger Building, 1 North Main Street, Coudersport, PA 16915. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain citizen views and comments on the County's proposed application for Disaster Recovery Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-DR) funds, and to receive any comments or grievances regarding the County's CDBG-DR funds. This meeting is accessible to individuals with disabilities and for persons with limited English proficiency. Furthermore, the County Commissioners shall not disclose any information which may, in the opinion of the Potter County Commissioners, be deemed of a confidential nature.
