

Title V Operating Permit 53-00008

Under 25 Pa. Code § 127.521, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) intends to issue a Title V Operating Permit to National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation for their East Fork Compressor Station located in Wharton Township, Potter County. The National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation representative to contact regarding the proposed operating permit is Luke Wolfe, Manager, 6363 Main Street, Williamsville, NY 14221-5855.

The facility has the potential to emit 89.61 tons of nitrogen oxides (NOx) per year, 119.61 tons of carbon monoxide (CO) per year, 45.00 tons of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) per year, 0.05 tons of sulfur oxides (SOx) per year, 4.07 tons of particulate matter (PM, including PM10 and PM2.5) per year, 4.25 tons of hazardous air pollutants and 27,142.01 tons of greenhouse gases. The engines are subject to 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart ZZZZ - National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Stationary Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines. The emergency generator engine incorporated into Source P112 is also subject to 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart JJJJ, Standards of Performance for Stationary Spark Ignition Internal Combustion Engines. Revisions include replacing one emergency generator with another emergency generator and replacing some small natural-gas-fired heaters. The emission limits, throughput limitations and work practice standards along with testing, monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting requirements have been included in the operating permit to ensure the facility complies with all applicable Federal and State air quality regulations. These operating permit conditions have been derived from the applicable requirements of 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart ZZZZ, 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart JJJJ, and PA Code Title 25 Article III, Chapters 121 through 145.

Any person(s) wishing to comment on the proposed permit which they believe should be considered prior to issuance of the revised permit, may submit comments to the Department of Environmental Protection, 208 West Third Street, Suite 101, Williamsport, PA 17701. A 30-day comment period from the date of this publication will exist for the submission of comments. Each written comment must contain the following: Name, address and telephone number of the person submitting the comments; Identification of the proposed permit (specify Permit No. TVOP 53-00008); Concise statements regarding the relevance of the information or objections to issuance of the permit.

A public hearing may be held, if the Department of Environmental Protection, in its discretion, decides that such a hearing is warranted based on the information received. All persons submitting comments or requesting a hearing will be notified of the decision to hold a hearing by publication in the newspaper or by the Pennsylvania Bulletin, or by telephone, where the Department of Environmental Protection determines such notification is sufficient.
