PA NRCS to Hold Local Working Group Meeting in Tioga County

On March 12th, at 10:00 a.m. at the Tioga County Conservation District, 1867 Shumway Hill Road, Wellsboro, PA 16901, the PA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) is hosting its annual Local Working Group meeting.

Local Working Groups were established to provide recommendations to NRCS on local natural resource priorities and criteria for conservation activities and programs. NRCS works with landowners through conservation planning and assistance designed to benefit the soil, water, air, plants and animals that result in productive lands and healthy ecosystems.

Participation is now open to all interested persons. Agricultural producers, owners/operators of nonindustrial private forest land, professionals representing agricultural and natural resources interests, and individuals representing disciplines in soil, water, wetland, plant, forestry, and wildlife sciences who are familiar with agriculture and natural resource issues in the local community are all invited to attend.

At the meeting, information will be presented about the current conditions of Tioga County's natural resources and dominant land uses, and participants will be provided an opportunity to help identify natural resource concerns and goals, examine new conservation opportunities, and prioritize areas where conservation efforts are most needed. Your participation will help plan for the protection and proper management of Tioga County's natural resources into the next century.
