

Public Notice

Pursuant to the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, the Coal Refuse Disposal Control Act, the Clean Streams Law, and the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, notice is hereby given that Phoenix Resources, Inc., 782 Antrim Road, Wellsboro, PA 16901, has made application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for renewing its existing surface coal mining permit and related NPDES Permit. The current surface mine permit No. 59060101 and NPDES permit No PA0256315 were originally issued on September 29, 2006 and will expire on September 29, 2026. There are two NPDES discharge points, #001(TF1) and #004(BA-1) associated with the mining permit. The receiving stream for the permit area is Rock Run, which flows into Babb Creek.

The operation is located in the Duncan Township, Tioga County and is known as a Residual Waste Landfill Operation. The mining permit area is 80.9 acres and is situated along southeast side of State Route 3009 otherwise known as Antrim Road. The site is located approximately one mile northeast from the intersection of Bridge and Main Street, Antrim, Pennsylvania. The receiving streams for the permit area are Rock Run and Babb Creek.

The Antrim, PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute topographic map contains the area described. A copy of the application is available for public inspection at the Tioga County Conservation District, 1867 Shumway Hill Road, Wellsboro, PA 16901.

Written comments, objections, or a request for public hearing or informal conference may be submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection, Moshannon District Mining Office, 186 Enterprise Drive, Philipsburg, PA 16866 by August 15, 2026, and must include the person's name, address, telephone number, and a brief statement as to the nature of the objection(s).
