

Resource Conservationist

Description:

The Resource Conservationist position is a full-time (37.5 hours/week) position. The position is responsible for administering programs delegated to the District by DEP concerning erosion and sediment pollution control, and stream and wetland encroachments (Chapter 102 & 105).

The position will be responsible for reviewing erosion and sedimentation control plans and permits, conducting inspections of earthmoving activities to ensure compliance with state and local regulations, investigating complaints, and providing education opportunities for contractors, engineers, municipalities, and landowners. The successful candidate must be able to think critically and communicate effectively through a variety of different methods.

Qualifications:

1. Qualified applicants are preferred to have a Bachelor's Degree in Natural Resources, Environmental Science, Biology, Hydrology, Aquatic Ecology, or other related field.
2. Candidates should be able to learn and become familiar with state and local regulations and learn to apply them.
3. Candidates must be able to obtain an Act 151 Child Abuse Clearance, and Criminal Background Check, and FBI Clearances.
4. Candidates with construction knowledge and/or heavy equipment background preferred.
