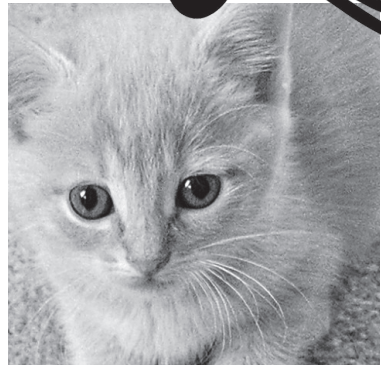
**Cause4paws is a small 501c3

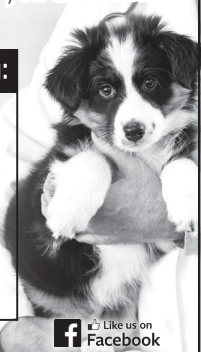
