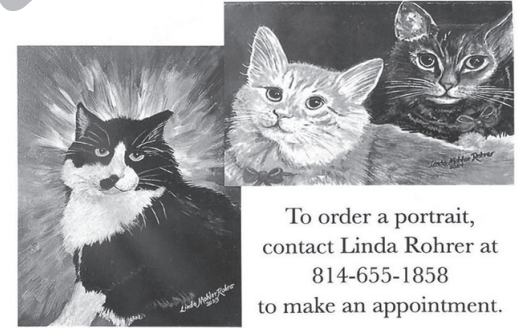
## WOULD YOU LIKE A PORTRAIT OF YOUR CAT?
