NOTIFICATION OF PLANNED POWER OUTAGE

Wellsboro Electric will interrupt power to all of its customers after midnight on Thursday, Sept. 24, for up to two hours as we convert over to our new transmission service.

The planned outage has been scheduled to take place between 1 a.m. and 3 a.m. in an effort to minimize inconvenience to our customers. In the event of rain, the outage will take place Friday, Sept. 25, at 1 a.m.

While we apologize for the interruption, it's important for customers to know that the work we will be performing marks the conclusion of a long-term project Wellsboro Electric initiated to improve service reliability for our customers and increase system capacity for future growth. The project began in 2004 with construction of a new substation on Buena Vista Street. The final phase of the project, construction of the new 115,000-volt transmission line from Niles Valley to the Buena Vista Street Substation, was completed this month. This new transmission line, which receives power directly from the state-wide transmission grid, will greatly enhance reliability for our customers.
