An Electronic Technician is responsible for the implementation and maintenance of electrical power circuits and equipment, control and automation systems, and electronic equipment used in pipeline systems, compressor stations, as well as interconnect and measurement facilities.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Installation, inspection, maintenance, calibration, and troubleshooting of electronic equipment such as telemetering, programmable logic controllers (including Allen-Bradley), modems, transducers, sensing devices, radio & satellite equipment, remote terminal units, computer interface equipment and cabling.
- Maintain power distribution systems including motor control centers, UPS, generators, and variable frequency drives.
- Provide coverage for electrical, mechanical, instrumentation and control logic systems for natural gas powered engines and turbines as well as reciprocating and centrifugal gas compressors. Provide inspection for construction and/or maintenance activities performed by third parties for compliance with safety, regulatory requirements, and NEC (National Electrical Code).

The successful candidate should possess an Associate's Degree in Electronics or have equivalent work experience, valid driver's license, the physical capability to work in and around hazards and difficult to reach areas, the ability to successfully work independently as well as within a team environment and excellent communication and computer skills. Prior experience and a thorough knowledge of NFPA National Electrical Code, single & three phase systems, digital & analog electronics, electronic test equipment, wiring methods and safety practices.

Applicants must be available to work Monday through Friday from 8:00 am and 4:30 pm and may include off hours, weekends, and holidays. **And must live within a reasonable commute of our Liberty, PA location at 66 Vail Town Rd, Liberty, PA 16930 or be willing to relocate. Candidates may be given 6 months from their hire date to permanently relocate.**
