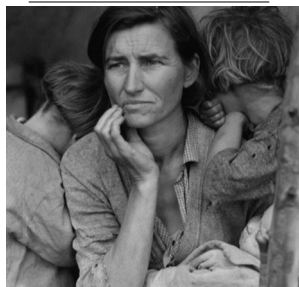


FOOD FOR THE HUNGRY

Who are we?



Joshua's is a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation dedicated to serving the hunger needs of the economically disadvantaged in the community. Joshua's is managed by a board of directors, business-people, and Christians of various denominations. Daily operations are conducted by the CEO, Board President, the Directors, and other volunteers who total hundreds of hours each month. **ALL ARE *UNPAID* VOLUNTEERS.**

What do we do?

Joshua's collects and distributes food such as bakery and dairy products, juices, meat, canned goods, cereals, and other non-perishable food items. We also distribute special foods to diabetics, people with high blood-pressure, & those with celiac disorder (allergy to gluten.) Everything is given away to our clients for free.

Where does the food come from?

The majority comes from churches, individuals, grocery stores, and businesses. The remainder is purchased in bulk.

Whom do we serve?

Joshua's serves families and individuals who are in need of assistance.

What determines need?

There are many reasons why people come to us: unemployment, excessive medical obligations, cuts in financial support, being financially overextended, alcoholism, drug use, broken homes, disasters, physical or mental disabilities, and other problems.

Qualified individuals may register to come once a week and receive bakery products, dairy products, and other surplus food items, when available.

Voucher boxes are obtained monthly through Joshua's in-house vouchers, School-Nurse vouchers, and Red Cross Disaster Relief vouchers.

Where are we?

Joshua's Storehouse & Distribution Center is located at 334 South Wolcott, in Casper, Wyoming. Thanks to generous grants from the City of Casper & Highland Park Community Church, we were able to re-surface & re-paint our building. Joshua's meets all food industry standards for product handling, storage, warehouse sanitation, and inventory control.
