IF DEMOCRAT OR INDEPENDENT ASK:

3. As you may know, in Wyoming a voter may only vote in a primary if they are registered as that part of that party, but any voter can change their party registration on the primary Election Day and vote in their new party's primary. Some voters we talk to tell us that they are likely to change their registration to Republican this year so that they can vote in the Republican primary. How about you, how likely would you say you are to change your registration to Republican so you can vote in the Republican primary elections? **ROTATE TOP-TO-BOTTOM, BOTTOM-TO-TOP**
