

FIRST-TEAM OFFENSE

Quarterback



Brady Fyfe

High school: Shade
Graduation year: 2019
Bio: Fyfe had 11,733 career total yards – 8,068 passing yards – and was part of 128 career touchdowns. The Tribune-Democrat Player of the Year and a Class A all-state selection in 2018, Fyfe had a Pennsylvania-best 4,947 total yards as the Panthers won a school-record 11 games. He led Shade to its first-ever WestPAC and District 5-A crowns. He completed 62.6% of his passes (232 of 356) for an area-best 3,677 yards and 46 TDs, including seven 300-yard passing games as a senior, and rushed for 1,270 yards and 17 TDs.

Quarterback



Logan Hauck

High school: Chestnut Ridge
Graduation year: 2018
Bio: A Class AA all-state selection as a senior, Hauck led the Lions to back-to-back District 5-AA crowns in 2016 and 2017. The dual-threat quarterback completed 64.8% of his passes (453 of 699) for 5,820 yards and 56 touchdowns. Hauck rushed for 2,439 yards and 39 TDs. As a senior he passed for 1,856 yards and rushed for 1,191 yards. Hauck threw for more than 2,000 yards as a junior.

Running Back



Braden Fochtman

High school: Berlin Brothersvalley
Graduation year: 2016
Bio: A two-time Tribune-Democrat Offensive Player of the Year and Class A all-state selection in 2014 and 2015, Fochtman had a Somerset County-best 6,724 career rushing yards. Fochtman averaged 8.9 yards a carry and 126.9 yards rushing a game. He had three consecutive seasons with 2,000-plus rushing yards and was part of two District 5-A championship teams, including a state semifinalist squad in 2015 when Berlin upset state power Clairton in the quarterfinals. Fochtman played four seasons at Division II Slippery Rock University.

Running Back



Brad Kanuch

High school: Westmont Hilltop
Graduation year: 2006
Bio: A two-time Tribune-Democrat first-team running back, Kanuch gained 2,367 rushing yards in his final two seasons with the Hilltoppers. He earned all-state honors at defensive back in 2005 and played in the Big 33 game. Kanuch won PIAA gold medals in the triple jump and 200-meter dash in state track. In 47 games at wide receiver for NCAA Division I University of Connecticut, Kanuch had 1,115 receiving yards.

Running Back



Antwuan Reed

High school: Greater Johnstown
Graduation year: 2008
Bio: A two-time Class AAA first-team all-state selection, Reed had 4,276 career rushing yards, including 1,915 as a senior in 2007, when he scored 26 TDs and had 158 points. A Big 33 game selection and USA Today/Old Spice Red Zone Player of the Year, Reed played four seasons and started two years as a cornerback at the University of Pittsburgh. He made 87 tackles and two interceptions on Panthers teams appearing in four bowl games. He signed with the Cleveland Browns as an undrafted free agent but didn't play in the NFL.

Running Back



Josh Seidel

High school: Bishop McCort Catholic
Graduation year: 2010
Bio: Seidel was a catalyst on Bishop McCort's 14-win PIAA Class A runner-up team in 2009. As a senior he rushed for school single-season records of 2,018 yards and 35 touchdowns. Seidel had a single-game record 327 rushing yards against previously undefeated Richland and tied his late father's single-game mark with six TDs. He appeared in Sports Illustrated's Faces in the Crowd and was a Pennsylvania Sports Writers All-State selection. He had 2,614 career rushing yards.

Wide Receiver



Caleb Burke

High school: Richland
Graduation year: 2020
Bio: Tribune-Democrat Player of the Year in 2019, Burke signed to play NCAA Division I football at the University of New Hampshire. The Class AA all-state selection helped the Rams reach the state semifinal round as a senior and was part of two District 6-AA and LHAC championships. Richland went 26-2 in his final two seasons. Burke caught 192 passes for 3,428 career yards and 43 TD receptions. A 1,000-point scorer in basketball, he was part of a Rams' state runner-up squad and two other teams that made deep PIAA playoff runs.

Wide Receiver



Dawson Snyder

High school: Shade
Graduation year: 2019
Bio: A key part of Shade's first WestPAC and District 5-A championship team in 2018, Snyder caught 71 passes for 1,053 yards and 12 TDs as a senior. He finished with 138 catches for 2,083 receiving yards, including 22 touchdowns. Snyder plays at NCAA Division I St. Francis University. He also scored 1,789 career points on the Shanksville-Stonycreek boys basketball team.

Wide Receiver



Aaron Tutino

High school: Ligonier Valley
Graduation year: 2019
Bio: A three-time Class AA all-state selection, Tutino set the Pennsylvania record in all classifications with 61 touchdown receptions. He had 206 catches for 4,120 career receiving yards while playing on two District 6-AA championship teams, including a state semifinalist. Tutino was Tribune-Democrat Offensive Player of the Year in 2018 with 1,363 receiving yards and 21 TD catches. He plays at NCAA Division I St. Francis University.

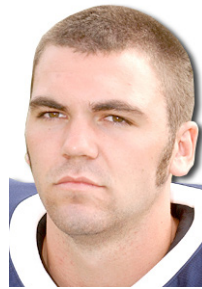
Tight End



Alec Bloom

High school: Ligonier Valley
Graduation year: 2014
Bio: An Associated Press first-team all-state and Big 33 selection, Bloom was a four-year starter at the University of Connecticut and a free agent signee with the NFL's Arizona Cardinals. As a senior at Ligonier Valley in 2013, Bloom caught 45 passes for 830 yards and 12 TDs as a USA Today All-Pennsylvania pick. He made 45 catches for 597 yards at UConn over four seasons.

Jeff Minemyer

High school: Bishop Carroll Catholic
Graduation year: 2006
Bio: The 6-foot-7, 257-pound Minemyer was a first-team all-state selection and Tribune-Democrat first-team all-area player with 20 catches for 301 yards in 2005. He was a second-team all-area selection as a junior. Minemyer was part of the NCAA Division I program at Rutgers though injuries curbed his career.

Tight End



Brian Shope

High school: Portage Area
Graduation year: 2003
Bio: Shope earned first-team all-state as a senior in 2002 and was a third-team pick in 2001. The 6-foot-5, 235-pounder had 21 catches for 373 yards as a senior and was fourth in the area with 102 points, including 17 TDs. As a junior he was second in the area with 12 sacks and had 120 tackles. Two-time Tribune-Democrat first-team all-area pick. In 44 games at NCAA Division I Marshall University, Shope had 19 catches for 200 yards.

Offensive Line



Mike Butterworth

High school: Northern Cambria
Graduation year: 2003
Bio: The 6-foot-7, 310-pound lineman started three seasons for the Colts and had a standout career at NCAA Division II Slippery Rock University before signing as an undrafted free agent with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons. A three-time PSAC Western Division first-team pick at Slippery Rock, Butterworth earned ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American first-team, ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District 2 first-team and was a PSAC Scholar-Athlete for three consecutive years

Scott Corson

High school: Greater Johnstown
Graduation year: 2006
Bio: An Associated Press Class AAA first-team all-state pick as a senior in 2005, Corson blocked for a unit that had success through the air and on the ground. Also had 90 tackles and 6.5 sacks on defense his final season. Was part of a District 6-AAA championship team as a junior, helping LaRod Stephens-Howling put up record numbers. Played on the offensive line at Division I University of Pittsburgh.

Steve Greene

High school: Bishop Carroll Catholic
Graduation year: 2009
Bio: Greene earned Associated Press Class A first-team all-state honors in his junior and senior seasons. The 6-foot-5, 311-pounder helped pave the way for the Huskies to rush for 2,402 yards in 2008 and 1,742 yards in 2007. Played offensive line at Division I Connecticut.

Ben Maderia

High school: Forest Hills
Graduation year: 2005
Bio: A two-time Associated Press all-state selection, Maderia was a first-team pick in Class AA as a senior in 2004 and a second-team pick as a junior in 2003. The 6-foot-3, 280-pound lineman anchored the Rangers' line. Maderia competed at St. Francis University for track and field.

Shane Rugg

High school: Bishop McCort Catholic
Graduation year: 2010
Bio: Rugg earned first-team all-state honors on the offensive line in 2008 and at defensive end in 2009. His senior season, he helped the Crimson Crushers advance to the PIAA Class A championship game as they finished runner-up to Clairton.

Brandon Vocco

High school: Portage Area
Graduation year: 2015
Bio: A two-time Tribune-Democrat first-team all-area selection and Class A all-state pick as a senior in 2014, Vocco was part of a Mustangs ground game that produced 4,439 rushing yards, 341.5 a game. A three-year starter at Division II Clarion University as a defensive tackle, Vocco was a two-time PSAC Western Division all-star, including a first-team pick as a senior. He participated in the Division II National Bowl and Tropical Bowl.
