**Tracy Unified School District Announces Extended School Closure  
to Include April 6-9<sup>th</sup>  
Tentative Return Date is Now April 20, 2020**

Dear Tracy Unified School District Families and Community,

The Tracy Unified School District continues to respond and make changes regarding COVID-19 based on the advice and guidance from the San Joaquin County Public Health Services, the San Joaquin County Office of Education, and the Governor of the State of California. Circumstances and information from these agencies changes daily, affecting the decisions that we make. This memo provides an update on the most recent information, as of today.

The original date of return to school was to be April 6, 2020, however, with April 10, 2020, being the start of our scheduled Spring Break (April 10 - April 17), we believe coming back for only 4 days would not be in the best interest of our students. Therefore, the closure which was announced on March 13<sup>th</sup> will be extended through our Spring Break, with a return to school date of **Monday, April 20, 2020**.

Meals will still be available at select locations, at no charge, for children ages 2-18 years of age as well as students in the Young Adult Program through April 9<sup>th</sup>. Please check the TUSD website or contact your school regarding meal pick-up times and locations. As has been past practice, there will be no meals served during Spring Break (April 10- April 17).

The Tracy Unified School District will continue to work with the government of California, the San Joaquin County Public Health Services (PHS) and the San Joaquin County Office of Education to monitor the situation and provide updates as necessary. There is a very good chance that school closures may be extended beyond Friday, April 17, 2020.
