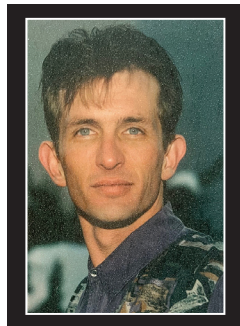




# Leonard Carl Smith
