
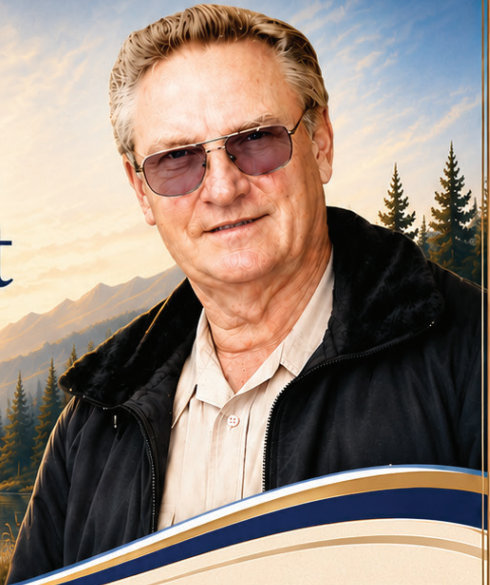




Alan C. Guilbert
