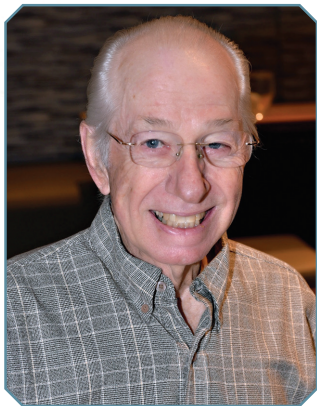

Charles Leon Siffing

With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of Charles Leon Siffing, known simply as Chuck, who passed away on November 25, 2025, at the age of 83, with loving family by his side at his home in Tracy, California.

Chuck was born on his family's farm October 12, 1942, in Vian, Oklahoma, to Glenn Harvey Siffing and Nona (Brown) Siffing. As a baby, he moved with his family to Winton, California and later to Stockton, where he graduated from Stagg High School in 1960. Chuck married his wife, Patricia in 1967 and the couple moved to Tracy in 1972.



Chuck worked as a welder at Libbey-Owens-Ford in Lathrop and later at Ad Art in Stockton before beginning a long and successful career with Allstate Insurance Company. He served the Tracy community as an insurance agent for more than 30 years, earning the trust and respect of countless clients. Chuck was deeply committed to his community. He became a member of the Kiwanis Club of Tracy in the early 1970s, where he served as a two-term president, advised local high school Key Clubs and helped with the Tracy High Junior Miss programs.

Active throughout his life, Chuck enjoyed softball, volleyball, fishing, dirt bike riding and go-kart racing. He was an avid bowler, often sharing his knowledge and coaching his daughters and others at the bowling alley. After retiring, he took up golf. A loyal sports fan, Chuck proudly supported the San Francisco 49ers, San Francisco Giants and Golden State Warriors.

Chuck loved music, especially Doo-Wop, Buddy Holly, Elvis and The Hollies. He could recount the life stories of singers and the history behind their songs with the upmost detail. Chuck was also a lover of animals and rarely without a dog or cat as his constant shadow. He enjoyed family barbecues and was known for making an excellent pot of chili and during holidays his delicious homemade fudge.

Above all else, Chuck cherished his family. He was a devoted husband, father and grandfather who rarely missed a moment—attending his daughters' sporting events, volunteering with the Tracy Triton Swim Team and later cheering on his grandchildren at their football, baseball, softball games, musical performances and dance recitals. He loved to travel and created lasting memories through annual family vacations to Yosemite, Santa Cruz, Lake Tahoe and many unforgettable cruises.

Chuck was preceded in death by his parents and his older brother, Glenn Dayton Siffing.

He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Patricia Siffing; daughters, Susan (Jason) Yonano of Turlock, California, Kari (Jon Green) Siffing of Livermore, California; his beloved grandchildren, Graysen and Conlin Yonano and Gage and Averly Siffing.

A true people person, Chuck will be deeply missed by his family and the many friends who were fortunate to know him.
