On January 28, 2025, Jorge Maximiliano Roesler, age 75, passed away peacefully from a heart failure due to health complications at the Emory Johns Creek Hospital in Johns Creek, GA. He was surrounded by his four children during his final days.

Jorge was born on April 11, 1949, in Mexico City, Mexico. In 1965, Jorge came to the United States with his mother, younger sister and two brothers,

settling in San Jose, CA. Jorge graduated from Pioneer High School in 1968 and enlisted in the United States Army in March of 1971, attending basic training in Fort Ord, CA. He was stationed at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, Company B 158th Aviation Battalion, 101st Airborne Division. He completed avionic mech school, earned his parachutist badge/jump wings, sharpshooter badge M-16, and was awarded the National Defense Service Medal. Jorge was honorably discharged from the United States Army, with the rank of Specialist Fourth Class, in March of 1974.



After completing his enlistment, Jorge moved back to California where he worked for several

different companies and eventually retired from the City of Fremont and settled in Tracy. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, cooking, old-western shows/moves, woodworking, tinkering and spending time with family and friends. He was most proud of his title of "Papa" and treasured the time he spent with his 10 grandchildren.

Jorge is preceded in death by his father, Jorge Enrique Roesler and mother, Hilda Lorens de Roesler.

He is survived by his sons, Jorge "Max" Roesler, Nathaniel Roesler, and Zachary Roesler; daughter, Alexandra Roesler; daughters-in-law, Aurora Roesler, Kimberly Roesler; grandchildren, Elena, Ava, Evan, Madyson, Justin, Jackson, Preston, Brooke, Kennedy, and Brendan; brothers, Oscar Roesler and Aaron Roesler; sister, Helga Roesler; aunt, Maria de Lourdes Lorens de Saggiante; and many other cousins and extended family.
