Roger Donnelly Fiack



A proud graduate of Tracy High School, Class of '64, Roger was known for his humor, athleticism, and sharp wit. He went on to attend Cal Poly San Luis Obispo where he majored in Farm Management - and unofficially

During the Vietnam War, he served two years in Germany as an Air Traffic Controller. The kids grew, the farming operation expanded, and in the early '90s the family moved to Sutter where they were never far away from a farm chore or a broken sprinkler head.

Though Roger and Jane eventually went their separate ways, he eventually reconnected with his college sweetheart, Joyce Schmidt, who became his beloved companion (and the only person willing to deal with his idiosyncrasies) for the past 20 years.

Roger lived a life marked by booming laughs, midday naps, curiosity, travel, and a tenacious drive to rid his orchard of squirrels. He set the standard for self-sufficiency and hard work; he didn't hesitate to lend a hand, but he would also give you a razzing while doing it. He was sarcastic, never got used to losing at dominoes, and was everyone's favorite bartender until the end.

Roger is survived by his daughters, Alicia Fiack of Grass Valley, Sara Fiack of Chico; a very good friend, Joyce Schmidt of Monterey; sister, Nancy Kahn of Roseville; brothers, Dave Fiack of Parker, CO, Jim Fiack of Chico.
