Minneapolis Flooded By 6 Foot Wall of Water

ST. PAUL, April 8.—With the breaking of an ice jam behind which was 1,000,000 feet of logs at St. River, thousands of miles north of here, a six-foot wall of water was released which reached Minneapolis shortly after noon.

At 2 a. m. government officials at the dam on the Mississippi river between St. Paul and Minneapolis said that the wall of water had reached the city.

At 2:15 a. m. the cargo on the government dam rose 45.20 feet with the river still rising. Two years ago when hundreds of families were forced to leave their homes to get out of the danger that threatened them, the dam was destroyed.

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SHIP WITH \$3,000,000 CARGO 12 DAYS OVERDUE IN PACIFIC
