When police call the Border Patrol The number of people Border Patrol apprehended after a call from another

law-enforcement agency has been declining in line with the overall trend. The share of total apprehensions that stems from those calls has held steady in the Tucson Sector at below 2 percent. In Yuma, the share fell from a peak of 13 percent in fiscal year 2010 to about 2 percent in fiscal year 2013. That year, there were 120,939 apprehensions in the Tucson Sector and 6,106 in the Yuma Sector.
