

ASSEMBLY CALLED OF MEN STUDENTS

A special assembly for all University of Arizona men eligible for selective service has been called for Monday at 4:40 p. m. in agricultural hall, it was announced by C. Z. Leshner, registrar.

Men are "required" to report for the assembly, he said in instructions which are to be read by every professor to his classes today. Men who must report at that time are those who were 21 years old before July 21, 1941, and registered for selective service. There were 356 of these men in the university as of registration last fall.

No amplification of why the assembly had been called could be obtained or any information as to what would be told the students.
