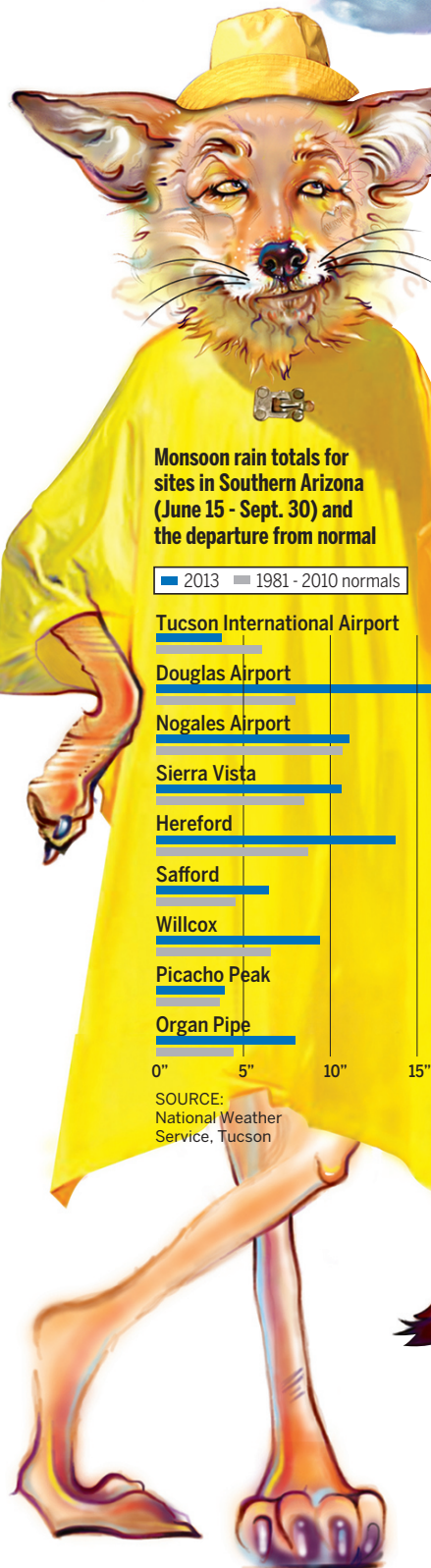


Monsoon 2013 rainfall totals

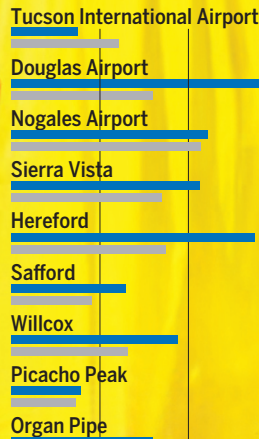
Monsoon 2013 was a hit-and-miss proposition for the greater Tucson area — but mostly a miss. The official reading at Tucson International Airport was 3.74 inches for the entire monsoon "season," designated by the National Weather Service as June 15 to Sept. 30. The median rainfall for the area was 3.75 inches. Normal monsoon rainfall for the area is 6.08 inches.

- 0 - 2.99 inches
- 3 - 3.49 inches
- 3.5 - 4.49 inches
- 4.5 - 5.99 inches
- 6 inches or more

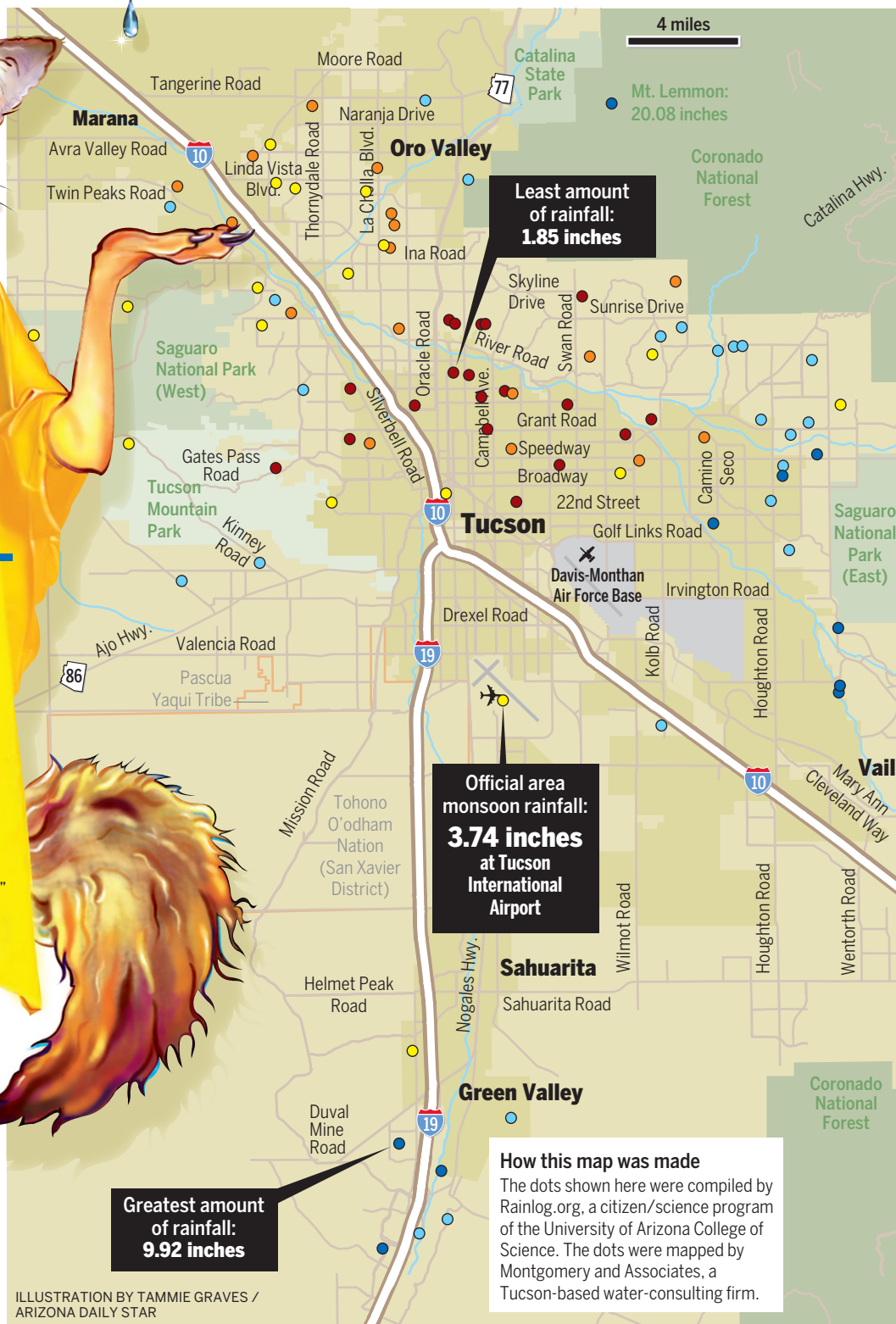


Monsoon rain totals for sites in Southern Arizona (June 15 - Sept. 30) and the departure from normal
