


City manager's recommendation for zoo expansion

The Tucson city manager will recommend to the mayor and City Council concept D for the Reid Park Zoo expansion project. The plan expands the zoo to the northwest, and would take over 4½ acres of green space from the park and 2.11 acres of hardscape while eliminating some of the zoo's parking lot. This would come with an estimated \$3.6 million in additional costs. The proposal spares the south duck pond and Barnum Hill from the expansion project.
