




Arizona cases




Arizona tests

The Star is accounting for a one-week lag in tests and cases reported to ADHS. We are accounting for a two-week lag for deaths and hospitalizations. Tests and cases are included through April 10. Hospitalizations and deaths are included through April 3.

The state breaks down COVID-19 cases and tests by county but does not make data on deaths and hospitalizations readily available by county.

The Star aggregates data by week to account for natural day-to-day increases and decreases throughout any given week. Weekly totals are aggregated from Sunday to Saturday.

Tests include PCR tests, also known as diagnostic tests.
