

RED CROSS HAS DISASTER PLAN

Committee Will Meet for Defense Discussion In Tucson

More than 70 members of the disaster relief committee of the American Red Cross will meet in the American Legion hall at 8 p. m. tomorrow in connection with the civilian defense program.

The call for the meeting was issued by Dr. Royal W. Rudolph, Tucson chapter chairman, following receipt of a statement of Red Cross responsibilities prepared jointly by Norman H. Davis, national chairman, and Fiorello H. LaGuardia, director of the Office of Civilian Defense.

Relief Plans

"The American Red Cross," the statement said, "is the responsible agency for relief of suffering both in peace time and in the national defense emergency, by providing food, clothing, shelter, medical and nursing care, and other basic necessities.

"Therefore, Red Cross disaster relief service, nationally and in local chapters, will serve in emergency care and rehabilitation of individuals and families suffering from disaster caused by belligerent action during the national defense emergency in cooperation with governmental agencies — national, state and local.

"In rescue work and emergency medical service caused by belligerent action, for which the Office of Civilian Defense assumes leadership and responsibility, the Red Cross will make the services available as needed."
