

PURVES TO CONDUCT SUTHERLAND BURIAL

Funeral services for William H. Sutherland, pioneer Tucson cattleman who died at his home 712 North Seventh street Thursday evening, will be held this afternoon at the residence at 3 o'clock. George T. Purves will officiate at the services after which the body will be shipped by the Reilly Undertaking company to Phoenix for cremation.

Mr. Sutherland came to Tucson in 1863 and has been in the cattle business in the community ever since his arrival here, his stock ranging in the Canada del Oro country near Oracle. For the past eight years he had been ill, the ranch being in charge of his son.

Douglas Cooper, a nephew, and his wife Mrs. Mildred Cooper, arrived from Douglas yesterday to attend the funeral services.
