Adolf Hitler had hoped to turn the 1936 Olympics into a showcase of Aryan supremacy. Those plans were foiled when Jess Owens became the first American to win four gold medals in track and field.

After the first day of the games, rather than congratulate Owens, Hitler decided not to publicly congratulate any winners.
