17 ISAIAH HODGINS VS C. ROLAND-WALLACE 4



Meet the leading receiver in the Pac-12. The 6-4 junior has gone from good to great, already reaching double figures in TD catches and landing on Pro Football Focus' Midseason All-America Team. He has a TD, 100-plus yards or both in six of OSU's first seven games.



The freshman is UA's most physical cornerback. Roland-Wallace has improved steadily over the course of the season after some early struggles, earning the trust of the UA coaching staff and the respect of opponents, who haven't thrown his way often lately.

99 ELU AYDON VS JOSH MCCAULEY 50



Aydon is a massive presence in the middle of the Beavers' defense, checking in at nearly 380 pounds. If Arizona wants to establish the run - something it has done to great effect in the past two meetings — it'll have to go through Aydon.



McCauley has been a model of consistency since becoming the starting center last season. The OSU game will mark his 21st straight start. He'll need to rely on angles and smarts vs. Aydon, who outweighs him by nearly 100 pounds.

WHEN OREGON STATE HAS THE BALL

No team in the country has taken better care of the football than the Beavers, who have just two turnovers. Senior QB Jake Luton has a sparkling 16-1 TD-INT ratio. OSU operates a balanced offense featuring veteran RB Artavis Pierce (6.0 ypc). His sidekick, Jermar Jefferson, the 2018 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year, is questionable (ankle). Arizona will be playing its first game with Chuck Cecil as defensive coordinator. Can he energize a stagnant group?

WHEN ARIZONA HAS THE BALL ...

While the chatter has been about the QB platoon the Wildcats debuted last week, the focus in this game will be on the running attack. Arizona rushed for 442 yards in last year's meeting, including 284 by J.J. Taylor. The Cats rushed for a school-record 534 yards against the Beavers in 2017. OSU has improved against the run — by about 90 yards per game — but still ranks 11th in the Pac-12 in that category.

PREDICTION: ARIZONA 41. OREGON STATE 27

Time is running out for the Wildcats, whose postseason hopes will be sunk if they don't beat the Beavers. Expect to see a spirited squad playing in throwback uniforms in front of a homecoming crowd. The key for Arizona is to sustain its intensity and sharpness for an entire game, something that has eluded the UA far too often. OSU is much improved but remains vulnerable on defense. Arizona has to win this game, and it will.
