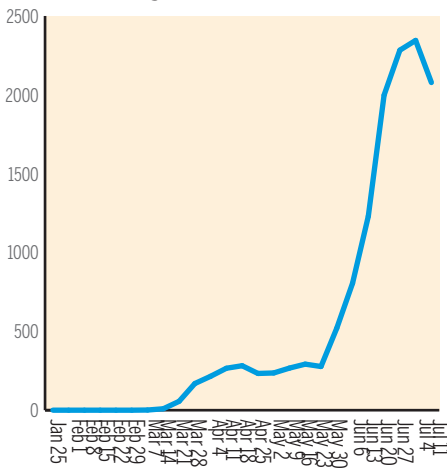
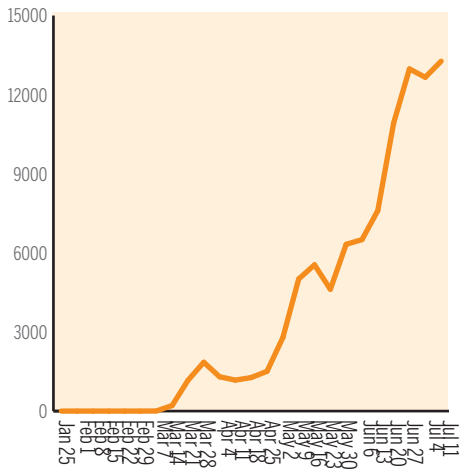

— Weekly cases

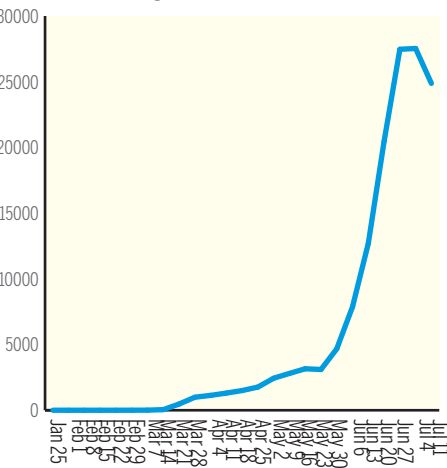

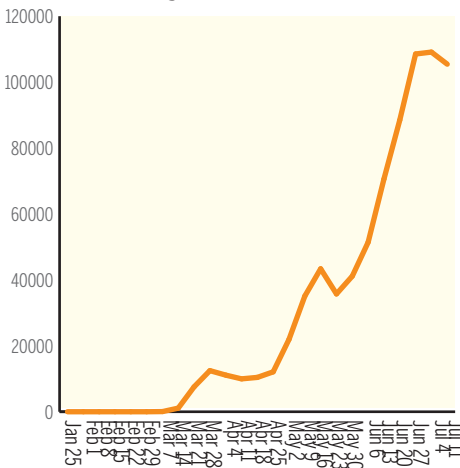


COVID-19 in Arizona

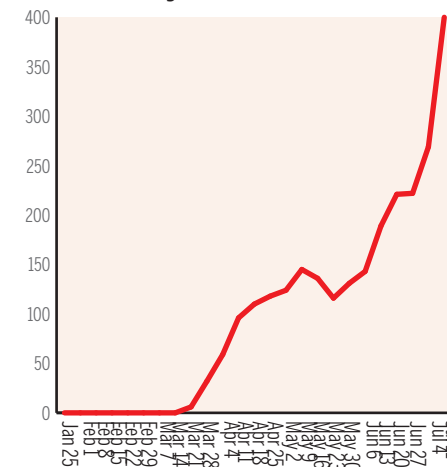

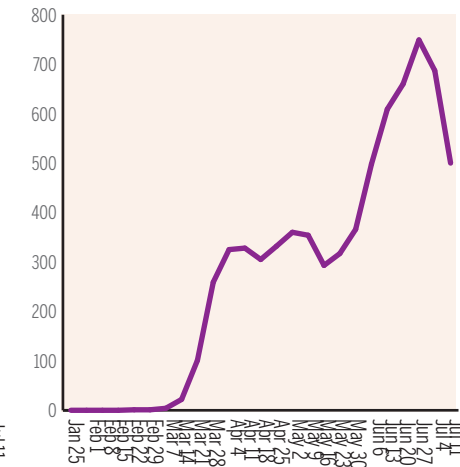

The Star has started accounting for a two-week lag in tests and cases reported to ADHS, instead of a one-week lag, due to longer data-reporting delays in recent weeks. We also account for a two-week lag for deaths and hospitalizations. Tests, cases, hospitalizations and deaths are included through July 11.

The state breaks down COVID-19 cases and tests by county but does not make data on deaths and hospitalizations readily available by county.

The Star aggregates data by week to account for natural, day-to-day increases and decreases throughout any given week. Weekly totals are aggregated from Sunday to Saturday.

Tests include PCR tests, also known as diagnostic tests.
