- The No. 5 seed Arizona will play the No. 4 seed USC in the quarterfinals of the Pac-12 Tournament after UA
 posted a 77-70 win over No. 12 seed Washington on Wednesday. Arizona is 5-1 all-time in the conference
 tournament against USC and 7-2 when playing the No. 4 seed.
- The Wildcats and Trojans split their two meetings this season, with both teams winning on their home court. In Tucson, the Wildcats lead by as many as 20 in the second half on their way to an 85-80 win. It was almost the opposite type of game in L.A. with USC winning by a score of 57-48.
- Under head coach Sean Miller, Arizona is 18-7 (.720) at the Pac-12 Tournament. Overall, Arizona is 34-15 in the
 Pac-10/12 Tournament and has won 7 championships in 11 appearances in the championship game.
- In Wednesday's win against Washington, the difference in the game came at the end of the first half and the start of the second half. Over the last 6:30 of the first half, Arizona did not make a field goal but was able to take a 5-point lead into the locker room. And then to start the second half, Arizona went on a 14-4 run over the first 5:45 to extend to a 15-point lead.
- Arizona ranks <u>14th In</u> the latest NET ranking (2nd in Pac-12) and a strength of schedule that ranks <u>SEVENTH</u>.
- After collecting 11 offensive rebounds against Washington on Wednesdsay, the Wildcats have registered 10+
 offensive rebounds in 17 of 19 games against Pac-12 teams this season. Arizona led the Pac-12 in offensive
 rebounding in conference play (11.67/gm) and is third in defensive rebounding (26.17).
- In conference play, Arizona ranked third in scoring (71.1) and second in fewest points allowed per game (65.1)
- For the season, Arizona is the only Pac-12 team that ranks in the top three in scoring offense and defense.
- UA leads the Pac-12 in fewest turnovers/game (11.9), and it would be the first time in 11 seasons under Sean Miller that the Wildcats led the conference in that category.
- Zeke Nnaji leads the Wildcats in fouls drawn (168), with Josh Green (101) and Nico Mannion (97) second and third. In Pac-12 play, Nnaji has been fouled 111 times in 19 games (5.8 per game).
- In 32 games this season, Arizona has scored 1,002 (31.3/game) points in the paint and 502 (15.7/game) fast break points.
- Arizona is forcing opponents into 14.6 turnovers per game, the highest average for any Sean Miller coached team. Thursday's win over Washington State improved the Wildcats record to 20-10 on the season, marking the 13th time in 16 years overall that head coach Sean Miller has reached the 20-win plateau.

PLAYER NOTES

- Zeke Nnaji, who was named the 2020 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year, opened the Pac-12 Tournaemtn with 11 poitns and nine rebounds against Washington and Isaiah Stewart. He went for his 14th double-double of the season (12p, 11r) against Washington to close the regular season. Nnaji's 14 double-doubles lead the Pac-12, rank third nationally among all freshmen and are second all-time by a freshman at Arizona (Ayton - 24). A 4-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week honoree, Nnaji led the Pac-12 in rebounding in conference play (9.2) and ranks seventh in scoring (16.1). Nnaji becomes the fifth UA player to be named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year under Miller and the 10th overall in program history. He is now eligible to have his name put into the Ring of Honor whenever his career at Arizona is complete.
- Nico Mannion's 169 assists are the third-most by a freshman at Arizona and rank second nationally among freshmen this season. He needs 9 assists to tie Mike Bibby for second place on the Arizona freshman assist list. His 5.3 assists per game rank second in the Pac-12 in conference play and his 14.0 points per game are good for 16th in the conference. He has scored in double figures in seven straight and has 36 assists in those seven games. Mannion has also drilled 53 3FG, which is the sixth-best total in Arizona history by a freshman. He recorded a season-high four steals against Washington in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament.
- Redshirt senior **Dylan Smith** played most of the game against Washington with a broken nose suffered in the first half. He went on to connect on 6-of-10 from long distance and led UA with 19 points in the game. Four days later at the Pac-12 Tournament against the Huskies, he recorded 14 points, four rebounds and tied his career high with six assists. He leads the Wildcats with 57 3FG made and is shooting 36.5 percent from distance this season.
- Josh Green returned to the starting lineup against Washington State on March 5 after missing two games (at USC, at UCLA) with a joint sprain in his lower back. In the three games since his return, he is averaging 13.0 points, 4.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists and shooting 45.8 percent from the floor and 75.0 percent (6-8) from the 3-point line. He is also 11-of-13 at the free throw line.
- As a starter, graduate transfer Stone Gettings has averaged 7.8p, 5.2r and shot 49.0% the last 16 games. He was named Pac-12 Men's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year as he has posted a 4.0 GPA while working towards his master's in accounting.
- Freshman big man Christian Koloko continues to impact winning, even if his line in the box score looks unimpressive on first glance. In 13:38 of action against Washington on Wednesday, he had a plus-minus of +12 despite scoring just six points and grabbing two rebounds. He blocked two more shots, giving him 25 on the year - the second-most on the team. He averages 4.27 blocked shots per 40 minutes, putting him in the top 25 in the country.
- Redshirt sophomore Jemarl Baker Jr. has 73 assists and just 23 turnovers this season.
