

U. A. PROFESSOR SAYS TERROR IS WEAPON OF K.K.K.

Hesitate in Expressing
Horror of Klan
Cowardice

Frank C. Lockwood, dean of the College of Arts, Letters and Sciences of the University of Arizona, said:

"It ought not to take many minutes for a true American to express his opinion of the Ku Klux Klan. It is un-American; it works under cover and works in the dark. It works by force and through terror. It pretends to establish law and order through lawless methods. All these things are true if we may trust the reports that constantly come through the press. Terrorism and bloodshed seem to be the peculiar marks of this organization. I have no respect for any man or any organization that assumes a disguise and works in the dark."
