


# Tucson's ARPA spending for public safety

The city of Tucson has allocated \$17.65 million in American Rescue Plan Act funds to spend on public safety efforts in fiscal year 2023, which started on July 1. The city was allocated \$136.20 million total as part of the COVID-19 relief package passed by Congress in March 2021.

### Violence interruption

A city initiative to combat violent crime
