You can add event photos and video links and schedule automatic reminders of events as well as reminders to your friends.

E-MAILING INFO TO THE STAR

Email is the best way to send information to the Star. It helps us make sure information is accurate and is the fastest way for us to get news to print and online readers. When submitting information for possible publication, we ask that you follow these guidelines:

- Include who's involved, what's going on, when and where it will be and how much it will cost
- Cut and paste your information into the message area of the email or use the most common attachments like Word or Rich Text
- Include the name of your organization and "Tucson" in the subject line
- Include a daytime phone number of a contact we can call with any questions
- Double-check that the information is complete and correct
- Spell out everything – no abbreviations
- Meet the deadline – submitting releases late means the information probably won't appear
- Work with one editor – do not send your information to multiple people at the Star.
- Call the appropriate editor immediately if your event

changes or there is an error; editors' names and numbers are at the top of the first page of each section

E-MAILING PHOTOS TO THE STAR

- Send photos along with your news to the appropriate editor
- Emailed photos should be saved as a JPEG file, at a resolution of 200 dpi and attached to the email
- Include the following information:

WHO is in the photo – all names must be spelled correctly and all persons in the photo must have given you consent to be published in the Arizona Daily Star

WHO took the photo or to whom it should be credited – this could be the photographer or the organization providing the photo

WHEN the photo was taken

WHERE the photo was taken – the physical location as well as the event
