TROYES IS CAPTURED First World War Lines Approached By Yank Army

SUPREME HEADQUARTERS ALLIED EXPEDITIONARY FORCE, Saturday, Aug. 26 – (P) — American tanks in a 23-mile advance yesterday rolled into Troyes, 85 miles southeast of Paris and 163 miles from the German border at the Rhine, while far behind them Allied armies were stampling out the last

## **AUG. 26, 1944: PARIS IS LIBERATED**

After four years of Nazi rule, Paris was liberated by French and American forces. A similar announcement had gone out two days earlier, but the Germans had resumed fighting.

This time, the German commander signed a document ordering his troops to cease fire. Parisians had fought inside the city against the Germans for almost a week. As the French and American armies moved in, there was fighting in the streets for the better part of the day before the cease-fire was declared.
