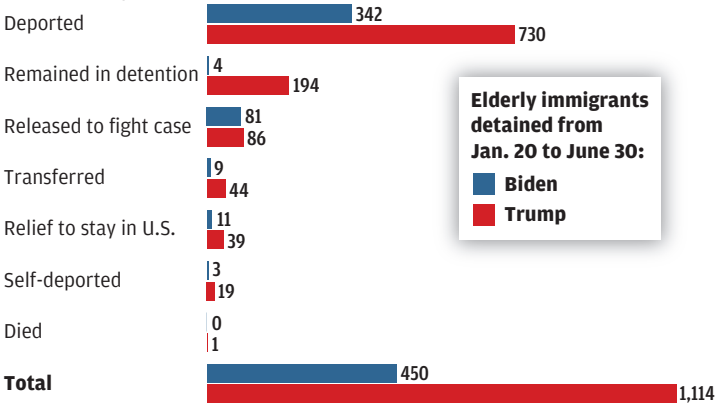

## ICE detentions of elderly people under Biden and Trump

The number of people age 65 and older who were detained by ICE in the U.S. during five-month periods under Biden and Trump are shown below. Under Biden in 2024, 18% of elderly people were released to fight their cases on bond, supervision or parole compared to just 8% under Trump in 2025.



Note: The full dataset extends through mid-October 2025, but the analysis ends in June to allow sufficient time to observe releases from detention. The analysis excludes one outlier. Data represents only those who were detained by ICE Enforcement and Removal Operations inside the country, not actions taken by Customs and Border Protection.

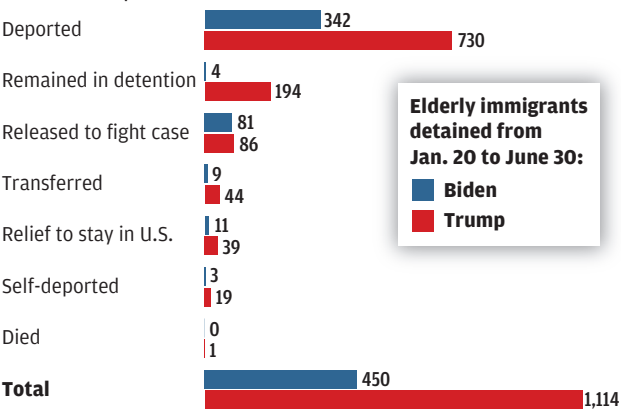
