Dear Mr. Pascoe:

This letter is in response to your public records request dated October 17, 2016, directed to the University of Arizona, seeking copies of the following records:

1. Written documentation of Arizona's drug testing and penalty policy for recreational and performance enhancing drugs, along with the annual schedule for both NCAA and Arizona conducted tests.

See records attached in response to this request.

2. Drug testing results for University of Arizona men's basketball players from Nov. 13, 2015 through the date of this letter (Oct. 17, 2016), including results from both NCAA testing (drug free sport) and UA testing. Also, if it is not clear in the results, a list of how many players were tested each time.

To the extent the records requested include student records, student records cannot be produced to protect the privacy interests of student-athletes, including under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), which mandates the University to maintain student education records in confidence.

3. Statements and any responses or results from any appeal to testing by the NCAA or UA, up to the date of response to this letter.

Appeal records, to the extent such records include student records, student records cannot be produced to protect the privacy interests of student-athletes, including under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), which mandates the University to maintain student education records in confidence.
