ELLINWOOD, VAN DYKE, CORRIGAN AND CAMPBELL HAND RESIGNATION TO GOVERNOR HUNT TOGETHER AT PHOENIX

PHOENIX, Ariz., Jan. 19 (A.P.)—The storm which has been gathering over the University of Arizona for more than a year broke late this afternoon when President Cloyd H. Marvin and four members of the board of regents tendered their resignations to Governor Geo. W. P. Hunt.

The regents who resigned were E. E. Ellinwood, president of the board; Cleveland H. Van Dyke, John H. Campbell and J. J. Corrigan. In explanation of his resignation, Ellinwood, said that "the discord and dissension which exists among some of the members of the board is real and irreconcilable." President Marvin issued a statement to the effect that "recent changes in the personnel" of the board "obviously establish a board which will be unsympathetic to the plans of the administration . . ."

Marvin assumed the presidency of the university in September, 1922, going to Tucson, from the southern branch of University of California. A flare-up in the relations between the president and faculty occurred last summer when the Tucson Ministerial association, backed by a group of dissident members of the faculty, brought charges against Marvin that he had "disrupted the morale of the faculty and student body." He was exonerated of the charges by the board of regents following a series of hearings.
