# By the numbers: University of Arizona vs. UA Global Campus

The University of Arizona and the University of Arizona Global Campus may have similar names and branding styles, but they are two distinct institutions accredited by two separate institutions. Up until about a year ago, UA Global, which is a nonprofit corporation, was known as the former for-profit Ashford University. Historically, Ashford, which will face trial Monday for a consumer protection lawsuit in California, has attracted more students from underrepresented backgrounds than many traditional four-year public universities. It's also struggled to deliver on student outcomes.

The share of students who graduated within 8 years of entering this school for the first time:




## Salary after completing program of study\*

Typical earnings in the second year after graduation with the range of highest and lowest median earnings for undergraduate and credential programs for which there is data:




#### Student body race/ethnicity
