LONDON, Feb. 13.—The long expected French announcement of the figures of their navy program for the year ending December 31, 1930, has been made. The figures would show that the Japanese delegation also made public an outline of its program, including a proposal to increase its fleet to 38 battleships, 10 aircraft carriers, 10 cruisers and 100 destroyers.
