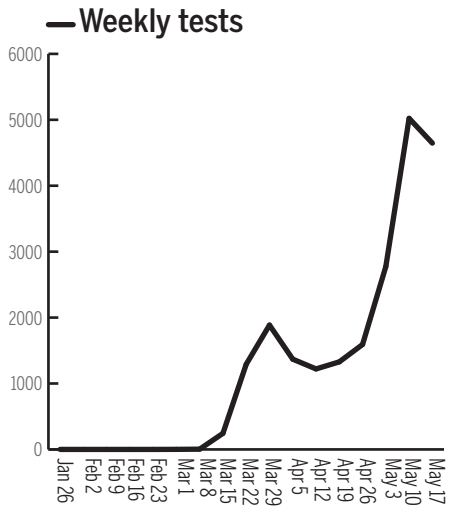
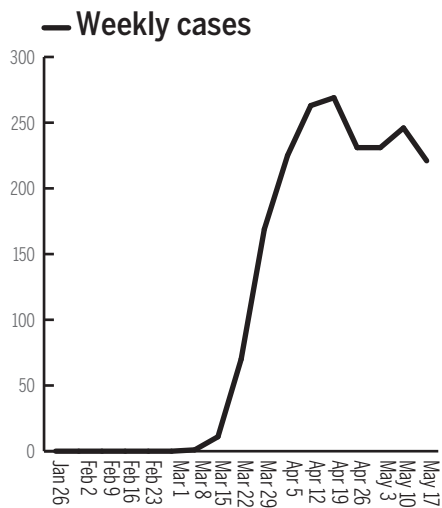
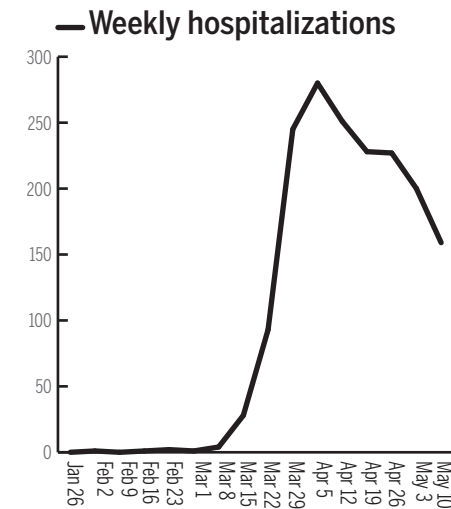
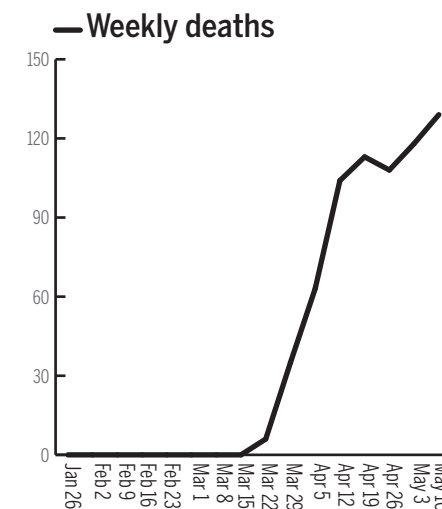
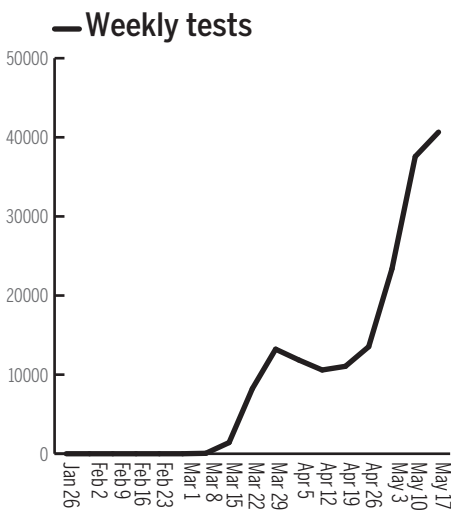
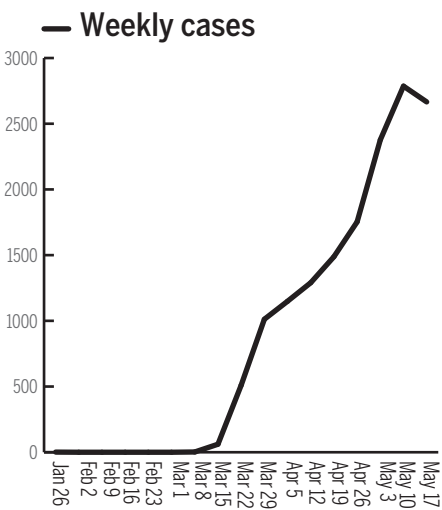


COVID-19 in Pima County

The Star accounts for a one-week lag in tests and cases reported to ADHS.

We account for a two-week lag for deaths and hospitalizations. Test and case numbers are included through May 17, while death and hospitalization numbers are included through May 10.

The state breaks down COVID-19 cases and tests by county, but data on deaths and hospitalizations are only readily available at the state level.

The Arizona Daily Star aggregates data by week to account for natural, day-to-data increases and decreases throughout any given week. Weekly totals are aggregated from Monday to Sunday.

Tests include PCR tests, also known as diagnostic tests.
